Welcome to the 2019 Season at the Limekiln Quarry. We are excited to be thinking about summer! **The following Announcements are important;** please contact a board member if you have any questions about the following items:

CLEANUP DAY: We need you! Many hands make light work and we need as many members as we can to tidy up the place before the season begins. The annual cleanup is planned for Saturday, May 11 at 9:00 a.m. (rain date of May 18). Please bring your rakes, gas leaf blowers, fishing waders, and shovels from home and if you have a wheelbarrow that would be a big help. Don't forget to bring a towel to dry your feet! The Board members put in a lot of time and effort on a volunteer basis to make Limekiln nice FOR YOU, so please give back in kind and support our clean-up effort! New members may pick up their keys during Clean Up.

ANNUAL MEETING: This year's annual meeting will be held at CLEANUP DAY at 9:00 am. Our primary objectives are to give a brief business overview and to vote to approve the current board. Of course, if any members wish to serve as a board member, they may put their names in the hat! If only the current acting board members are on the ballot, the vote will be to approve as is. Responsibilities include: attending three/four Board meetings per year, listing phone number on documents and web site, helping with maintenance, answering member questions, etc. Please contact Mike Zadlo prior to the **May 11th** annual meeting if you are interested in putting your "name in the hat."

OPENING DAY: Our official opening will be June 25th. Beginning on Memorial Day **weekend (May 25th)** lifeguards will be on duty on weekends only. After June 25th, they will be on duty seven days a week from 12:00pm-5:00pm.

SWIM LESSONS: We are offering swim lessons again this year to members. Dates and sign-up information will be sent in a separate email soon.

REMINDERS: No pets are allowed on the grounds at all at any time. Members are responsible for cleaning any picnic garbage up and for putting away any toys in the community bin. A soft copy of the by-laws may be obtained from any board member.

GATE: When the lifeguard is NOT on duty, the gate must remain closed/locked. This means you will need your key to get in OR out. Please always remember your key. Keys may be obtained on cleanup day or from our key master in person. If a lifeguard or board member doesn't recognize you, make it a point to get to know them! Everyone must check in, including your guests. The guard may ask to see your key to ensure you are a member. Both gates must be locked at all times after the guard leaves at 5pm.
